



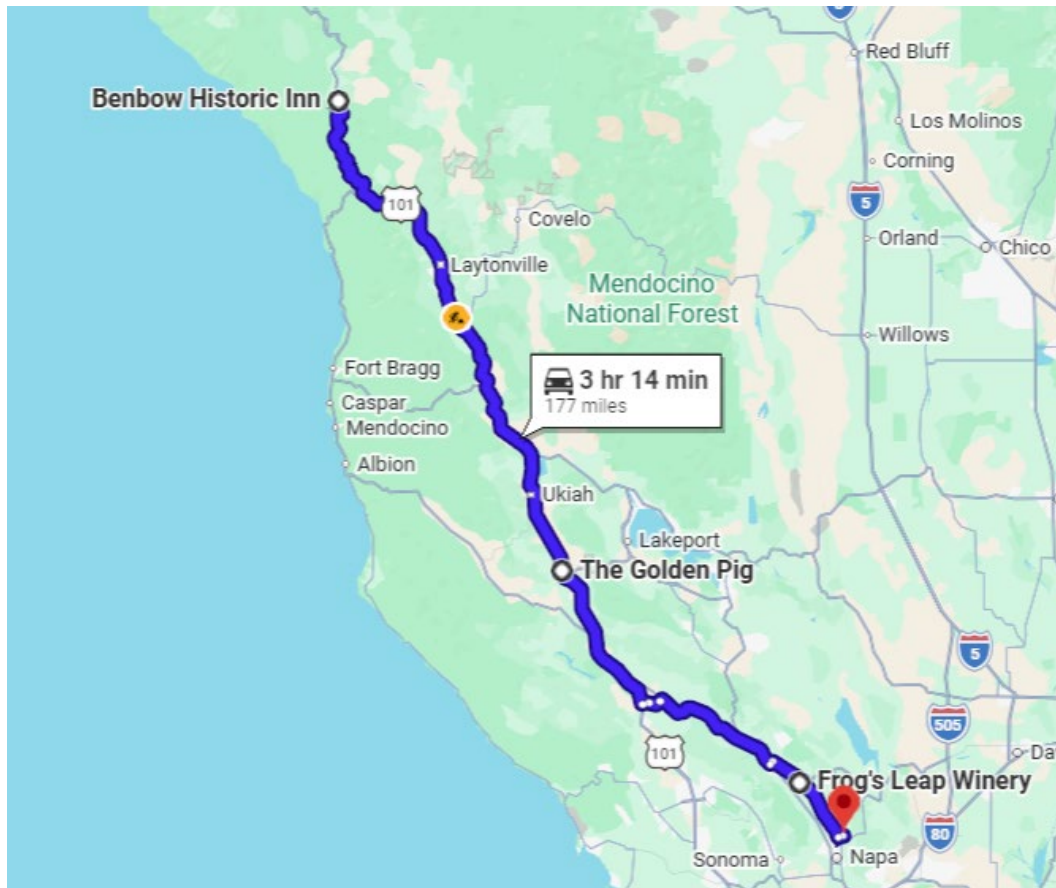
HEALEY 75th ANNIVERSARY MEET

PRE/POST TOURS

AVENUE OF THE GIANTS TO NAPA, INLAND ROUTE

(3:15 hours, 177 miles)

If the long coastal route is not your thing, and you are more interested in the Napa Valley wine scene, here is a much shorter route, though still quite scenic. The route includes a lunch stop in Hopland with a couple of excellent choices and a winery tour and tasting at **Frog's Leap**. The recommended hotel is the **Silverado Resort**, just a short drive from downtown Napa.

- Depart the Benbow Inn onto Hwy 101 South.
- In 101 miles, arrive in Hopland for lunch, at 101 and Center Drive, on the right.
 - **The Golden Pig** has a wide selection of international favorites ranging from Quesadillas to Chicken Pot Pies to Pork Schnitzel. Plenty of burgers and larger plates tending to Italian. Open every day at 11am. Dog friendly on the patio.
 - Just a bit further down the street, on the left, you will find the **Stock Farm Inn and Pub**. The feature here is real Wood Fired Pizza, though there are some salad, sandwich and pasta options. Open Friday to Sunday for sure. Maybe on other days in summer.
- Continue on Hwy 101 South.
- In 27.6 miles, take Exit 507 toward Alexander Valley Road. Green sign “Alexander Valley Rd”.
- At the end of the ramp, left onto Lytton Springs Road.
- In 0.2 miles at the T, left onto Lytton Station Road.
- In 1.4 miles at the T, left onto Alexander Valley Road. Green sign “Alexander Valley Road”.
- In 2.1 miles, in Jimtown, the road bends right and becomes Hwy 128.
- Next 24.2 miles, enjoy the Anderson Valley Wine Country.
- Coming into St. Helena, turn left onto Deer Park Rd. Green sign “← Deer Park Road”.
- In 0.6 miles, turn right onto Silverado Trail. Green sign “Napa →”.
- In 4.9 miles, turn right onto Hwy 128E, Green sign “→ Rutherford 3”.
- In 1.0m miles, right into **Frog’s Leap Vineyards**. Watch for a little A-frame sign.

Frog’s Leap Vinyards, Rutherford, CA

Frog’s Leap is one of the more laid-back wineries in the Anderson and Napa Valleys. That said, the days of free wine tastings are LONG gone. Virtually every area winery offers some form of tasting program at varying prices. Most (including this one) require advance reservations. Frog’s Leap offers three levels of tours, ranging from the 90 minute/\$100 immersive tour, to the \$50 tasting-only option. Check it out and book (even on the same day if they have space) at frogleap.com/visit-us/.

- Return to Silverado Trail and turn right.
- In 12.3 miles, turn left onto Hardman Ave. Green street sign only “Hardman Ave”. The Burgess winery is on the right (stone sign).
- In 0.9 miles, turn right onto Atlas Peak Road. The hotel is 0.1 miles ahead, on the left.

- **Don't Miss Drive:** Take the Silverado Trail north to Calistoga (mud baths) then cross over to Hwy 128 and Hwy 29 South, back to Napa. You'll pass through all the famous vineyards.

- **If you have time, visit Sonoma Valley:** "Next Door" to Napa Valley to the West and running parallel to the Napa Valley is Sonoma Valley, another great wine growing region. Take Hwy 12 to Santa Rosa, then Hwy 101 South towards San Francisco.

- **A secret drive that even Northern Californians don't know!**

Since you have already driven much of the Silverado Trail and only lack a bit of time on the parallel Hwy 29, here's a back country drive that will complete your exposure to the Napa Valley. 1 ¼ hours, 45 miles.

- Exit the hotel and turn left onto Atlas Creek Road.
- In 0.8 miles, at T and stoplight, left onto Hwy 121/Monticello Road. Green sign "Monticello Road".
- Enjoy this scenic driving road.
- In 11.2 miles, left onto Hwy 128/Capell Valley Road. Green sign "← Rutherford, 128". Several wineries along this stretch.
- In 15.9 miles at T, right onto Silverado Trail. Green sign "Rutherford, Calistoga, 128 →".
- In 0.1 miles, turn left onto Hwy 128. Green sign "← Rutherford 2".
- In 1.3 miles, bend right to stay on Hwy 128 toward Rutherford.
- In 1.5 miles, at stop sign in Rutherford, turn right to stay on Hwy 128/Hwy 29. Green sign "128 →, 29 ← →". Pass by the famous *French Laundry* restaurant.
- In 9.0 miles, at stoplight, turn left onto Oak Knoll Ave. Green sign "← Oak Knoll Ave".
- In 1.2 miles, left onto Big Ranch, then an immediate right back onto Oak Knoll Ave. Well signed.
- In 0.8 miles, at stop sign, turn right onto Silverado Trail. Green sign "Silverado Trl".
- In 2.1 miles, left onto Hardman Ave. Green street sign only "Hardman Ave". The Burgess winery is on the right (stone sign).
- In 0.9 miles, turn right onto Atlas Peak Road. The hotel is 0.1 miles ahead, on the left.

- **Information about Sausalito and visiting San Francisco**

- If you are staying a couple of nights in the SF area, consider a hotel in **Sausalito**, a laid-back community just north of SF beyond the **Golden Gate Bridge**. Besides touring Sausalito, you can take a ferry to **Fisherman's Wharf (Pier 39)** in San Francisco and make a day trip without the hassle of driving and parking in the City. After a crab lunch at the Wharf, visit nearby **Hyde Street Pier, The Cannery and Ghirardelli Square**, then grab the **Cable Car** (blue line Powell-Mason) at the corner of Hyde and Beach. Ride the car all the way to **Union Square** with a possible stop off in **Chinatown**. Retrace your route to Pier 39 and return to Sausalito.
